**Class 1 trip to 'The Muddy Education Centre, Holdenby' – Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> November 2020**

Next term, our topic is called 'Home Sweet Home' which focuses on houses, buildings and materials.

We have decided to start the topic with a trip to The Countryside Education Centre at Holdenby. On Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> November 2020, the children will be spending the day outside, building dens, looking at animal habitats and taking part in campfire activities.

On Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> November, we will be leaving school at 9:30 am and returning in time for the children to go home at 3:15 pm.

The children will need to wear warm clothes and wellies, they will need waterproof coats (and waterproof trousers if you have them) and hats and gloves. Children may put on their 'Welly Wednesday' wellies once they get to school in the morning, if you prefer.

The children will need to bring a small bag/rucksack with a packed lunch and a drink.

To help fund the trip, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £18.80 per child. Please complete the permission slip below and return it to school along with your payment (either cash or cheque) by **Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2020**. If you would like to pay by bank transfer instead, please send your payment to Barclays Bank, sort code – 20 17 68, account number – 43611264, The Bliss Charity School. Please use your child's name as the reference.

Please be assured that all appropriate control and safety measures have been considered to minimise any foreseen risks. All school trips go through a very thorough planning process, which involves guidance and approval from a third-party risk assessment company. As part of this, we have collated risk assessments from both The Muddy Education Centre and the coach company. Extra COVID-19 related precautions will be in place throughout the day. These will be similar to what the children experience during the school day. This includes handwashing at regular intervals, use of antibacterial hand gel, extra cleaning of surfaces, lots of tissues and staying outside as much as possible.
